Other ad hoc arrangements are not listed below but still need to be notified to the BHA.

The services generally provided under these arrangements include blog posts, social media work, Q&A sessions, attendance at company functions, photo shoots, video content, yard visits and a commitment to wearing branded clothing.

The BHA issues guidance to trainers, jockeys and betting operators to seek to protect the integrity of horsemen, betting operators and British Racing against the misuse of inside information. The BHA monitors the acceptability of these arrangements on an ongoing basis, as well as having regard to public perception.
