Whip Review Committee Decisions 27 October 2023

On Friday 27 October 2023 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards for races run from 23 October – 25 October 2023, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Wolverhampton 23 October 2023

RACE 8 THE BETUK. IT'S WHERE THE UK BETS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Daniel Muscutt, the rider of the winner, FAST AFFAIR, was found to have used his whip in the incorrect place. He will be suspended for 4 days as follows: Friday 10, Saturday 11, Monday 13 and Tuesday 14 November.

Following riders' admissions of a breach of Rule (F)45, the following penalties were applied by the racecourse Stewards.

Wolverhampton 23 October 2023

RACE 4 - 5:10PM. THE BUILD YOUR ACCA WITH BETUK HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV I)

Zak Wheatley, the rider of BASHOLO (IRE), placed third, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of 6 in the home straight. He will be suspended for 4 days from Monday 6 to Thursday 9 November inclusive.
