

Whip Review Committee Decisions 25 April 2023

On Tuesday 25 April 2023 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards for races run from 20 April 2023 – 23 April 2023 inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Ripon 20 April 2023

Race 1 – The Go Racing in Yorkshire Apprentice Handicap Stakes (Class 4) (Yorkshire Future Stars Apprentice Series)

Mark Winn, the rider of HORTZADAR, placed second, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from approximately two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Tuesday 9 to Friday 12 May inclusive.

Bath 21 April 2023

Race 2 - The Showcasing Standing at Whitsbury Manor Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Sean Levey, the rider of TAMANGO SANDS (IRE), unplaced, was found to have used his whip without giving his mount time to respond from approximately two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Tuesday 9 to Friday 12 May inclusive.

Bangor-On-Dee 22 April 2023

Race 3 – The Kate Hinkins 40th Birthday Celebration Handicap Hurdle Race (Class 4)

Charlie Maggs, the rider of TARAGRACE (IRE), placed second, was found to have used his whip twice above the permitted level of seven from after the third last flight. He will be suspended for 7 days from Tuesday 9 to Monday 15 May inclusive.

Ayr 22 April 2023

Race 5 – The Coral Scottish Grand National Steeple Chase (Class 1) (Premier Handicap) (GBB Race)

Alex Edwards, the rider of MAGNA SAM, placed fifth, was found to have used his whip without giving his mount time to respond having jumped the second last. He will be suspended for 4 days from Tuesday 9 to Friday 12 May inclusive.

Nottingham 22 April 2023

Race 6 - The Castle Rock Elsie Mo Flyer Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Rose Dawes, the rider of OBAMA ARMY, placed second, was found to have used her whip once above the permitted level of six from approximately two furlongs out. She will be suspended for 4 days from Tuesday 9 to Friday 12 May inclusive. The Committee ordered that one of these days shall be spent at the British Racing School for training.



Stratford-On-Avon 23 April 203

Race 6 - The Racecourse Streams on Racing TV Extra Handicap Steeple Chase (Class 5)

Tom Bellamy, the rider of CARDBOARD GANGSTER, placed second, was found to have used his whip in the incorrect place on the run to the line. He will be suspended for 4 days from Tuesday 9 to Friday 12 May inclusive.
