- Provide intelligence support to other members of the Integrity & Regulation Dept. as required.
- Assist the Intelligence Manager to maintain links with Racecourses in respect of up-to-date contact lists, CCTV systems/passcodes and signage.
- To assist the Intelligence Manager in the production of intelligence briefings (for internal & external use), information requests and intelligence disseminations.
- To provide administrative support to the Intelligence Manager in respect of the Weekly Intelligence Meeting.
- Assist the Intelligence Manager in collating Strategic and Tactical intelligence in support
 of the relevant Assessments, Control Strategy and Threat Assessment.
