

INITIAL CHECKS

- 1 Has every entry been signed and stamped by a veterinary surgeon? **If no, reject**
- 2 Has a valid vaccination been given on each occasion? **If no, reject**
- 3 Are all the correct vaccination details present (vaccine brand name, batch number and expiry date)? **If no, reject**
- 4 Were all the vaccinations administered prior to their expiry date? **If no, reject**
- 5 Are there any vaccination date alterations or has Tippex been used to correct a date? **If yes, reject unless separate verification of the date in question can be provided or the entry has been deleted and rewritten in full**

CHECKING DATES

Was the horse's vaccination course started prior to 2022?

Primary course should follow OLD vaccination intervals:

**(V1-V2: 21-90d)
(V2-V3: 150-215d)**

The horse must have then followed a 12 month booster schedule but needs to have received a booster in the 6 calendar months PRIOR to 14.01.2023. Strict 6 calendar monthly boosters are required thereafter

Latest vaccination given must be within 6 calendar months but not within 7 days of raceday

Primary course should follow NEW vaccination intervals:

**(V1-V2: 21-60d)
V2-V3: 120-180d)**

Strict 6 calendar monthly boosters are required thereafter

Latest vaccination given must be within 6 calendar months but not within 7 days of raceday

NB We also accept a primary course that has been started in 2021 for which the NEW 2022 vaccination intervals have been used. We always try to find a coherent vaccination course, even if this means ignoring unnecessary additional (potentially early) vaccinations.
