Whip Review Committee Decisions 2025:

On Tuesday 02 September 2025 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards and their own independent review of races run from 28 August 2025 – 31 August 2025, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Ffos Las 29 August 2025:

Race 5 - The Best Odds Guaranteed On dragonbet.co.uk Handicap (Class 6)

Tyrese Cameron, the rider of the winner BERKSHIRE SMUDGE (IRE), was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from approximately three furlongs out. Taking into account that this was to be Cameron's fourth suspension within the previous 6 months for using his whip above the permitted level, Cameron was referred to the Judicial Panel.

Beverley 30 August 2025:

Race 6 - The Constant Security Handicap (Class 5)

Conor Orr, the rider of EMPEROR'S SON (IRE), unplaced, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from approximately two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Tuesday 16 to Friday 19 September 2025, inclusive.

Brighton 31 August 2025:

Race 1 - The Make A Difference Amateur Jockeys' Handicap (Class 6)

Miss Louise Chance, the rider of NOBLE PHOENIX (IRE), unplaced, was found to have used her whip when her mount was out of contention from three and a half furlongs out. She will be suspended for 8 days as follows Thursday 18, Saturday 20, Sunday 28, Monday 29 September 2025, Wednesday 01, Monday 06, Monday 13 and Friday 17 October 2025.

ARO race - The CARBONETZERO HANDICAP STAKES.

Miss Teagan Padgett, the rider of ZIZANIA DU MAZET (FR), placed fourth, was found to have used her whip once above the permitted level of six from inside the final three furlongs. She will be suspended for 4 days as follows; Thursday 18, Saturday 20, Sunday 28 and Monday 29 September 2025.
