

Whip Review Committee
Decisions 7 November 2023

On Tuesday 7th November 2023 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards for races run from 2 November – 5 November 2023, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Ascot 4 November 2023

Race 1 – The Grndon Waste Management Conditional Jockeys' Novices' Handicap Hurdle Race (Class 4) (GBB Race)

Shane Quinlan, the rider of ED KEEPER (FR), placed second, was found to have used his whip twice above the permitted level of seven from approaching the second last flight. He will be suspended for 7 days from Tuesday 21 to Monday 27 November inclusive.

Following riders' admissions of a breach of Rule (F)45, the following penalties were applied by the racecourse Stewards.

Chelmsford City 4 November 2023

Race 1 – The CCR Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Shariq Mohd, the rider of EXIGENCY, placed second, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from inside the final two furlongs. He will be suspended for 4 days as follows: Saturday 18, and Monday 20 to Wednesday 22 November.
