

Whip Review Committee
Decisions 12 July 2024

On Friday 12 July 2024 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards and their own independent review of races for races run from 8 July – 10 July 2024, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Brighton 9 July 2024

Race 1 – The Get The Inside Track With Raceday-Ready.Com Classified Stakes (Class 6)

Molly Gunn, the rider of HURRICANE ALERT, unplaced, was found to have used her whip once above the permitted level of six from two furlongs out. She will be suspended for 4 days as follows: Friday 26, Sunday 28, and Monday 29 July, and Friday 2 August.

Ffos Las 10 July 2024

Race 4 – The Connolly Red Mills Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Finley Marsh, the rider of MAWADA (IRE), unplaced, was found to have used his whip in the incorrect place. Taking into account that Marsh has had over 200 rides in Great Britain since a previous whip breach, mitigation on penalty was applied. Therefore, he will be suspended for 2 days: Friday 26 and Sunday 28 July.
