Whip Review Committee Decisions 18 July 2023

On Tuesday 18 July 2023 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards for races run from 13 July 2023 – 16 July 2023, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Newmarket 13 July 2023

Race 2 – The Kingdom of Bahrain July Stakes (Class 1) (Group 2)

TOCA MADERA (IRE), placed third, ridden by Sean Levey, was found to have minor weals postrace. Levey will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 4 to Monday 7 August inclusive.

Carlisle 13 July 2023

Race 1 – The Lake District Handicap Stakes (Class 5) (Jockey Club Grassroots Middle Distance Series Qualifier)

Nicola Currie, the rider of KEHLANI (IRE), placed fourth, was found to have used her whip once above the permitted level of six from inside the final 3 furlongs. She will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 4 to Monday 7 August inclusive.

Race 6 - The Muckle Majestic Handicap Stakes (Class 5)

Ryan Sexton, the rider of the winner, DANDY'S ANGEL (IRE), was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from one and a half furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 4 to Monday 7 August inclusive.

Doncaster 13 July 2023

Race 1 – The Sky Sports Racing HD Virgin 519 Amateur Jockeys' Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Miss Katie Garton, the rider of ROBEAM, unplaced, was found to have used her whip down the shoulder in the forehand position. She will be suspended for 4 days as follows: Friday 4, Monday 7, Tuesday 8, and Wednesday 9 August.

Ascot 15 July 2023

Race 6 - The Village Hotels Fillies' Handicap Stakes (Class 3)

Georgia Dobie, the rider of BERNADINE (IRE), placed second, was found to have used her whip once above the permitted level of seven from approximately two furlongs out. She will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 4 to Monday 7 August inclusive.

Salisbury 15 July 2023

Race 5 - The Tony Brown Fillies' Handicap Stakes (Class 4)

Joshua Bryan, the rider of MLLE CHANEL, placed third, was found to have used his whip without giving his mount time to respond approximately two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 4 to Monday 7 August inclusive, one of these days will be spent receiving specialised training.

Hamilton 15 July 2023

Race 5 – The Book Your Tickets @hamilton-park.co.uk Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Mark Winn, the rider of JAMINOZ (IRE), placed second, was found to have used his whip twice above the permitted level of six from two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 7 days from Tuesday 1 to Monday 7 August inclusive, one of these days will be spent receiving specialised training.
