Whip Review Committee Decisions 18 October 2024:

On Friday 18 October 2024 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards and their own independent review of races for races run from 14 October – 16 October 2024, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Windsor 14 October 2024:

Race 6 - The Get Raceday Ready Handicap (Div II) (Class 6)

Jordan Wiliams, the rider of ZAMBEZI MAGIC, placed third, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from approximately two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 01, Saturday 02, Monday 04 and Tuesday 05 November 2024.

Wolverhampton 14 October 2024:

Race 6 - The Free Digital Racecard At raceday-ready.com Handicap (Div I) (Class 6)

Andrew Elliott, the rider of RUBELLITE (IRE), place third, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six approaching the final furlong. He will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 01, Saturday 02, Monday 04 and Tuesday 05 November 2024.

Race 8 - The At The Races App Form Study Handicap (Class 5)

Joe Leavy, the rider of the winner, BESET, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from entering the home straight. As Leavy was referred to the Judicial Panel on 26 June 2024 for 'totting up' previous whip offences, the deferred suspension of 8 days was imposed by the Panel for a further whip breach within the next 6 months was triggered. Therefore, Leavy will be suspended for 11 days as follows: Friday 01, Saturday 02, Monday 04 to Saturday 09, and Monday 11 to Wednesday 13 November 2024.

Race 9 - The Get Raceday Ready Handicap (Class 6)

Morgan Cole, the rider of the winner, CERULEAN SUMMER (IRE), was found to have used her whip once above the permitted level of six from turning into the home straight and in the incorrect place on the run to the line. She will be suspended for 8 days as follows: Friday 01, Saturday 02, and Monday 04 to Saturday 09 November 2024. One of these days will be spent receiving specialised coaching.

Nottingham 16 October 2024:

Race 7 - The Trustatrader Approved And Reviewed Trades People Amateur Jockeys' Handicap (Class 6)

Mr Eireann Cagney, the rider of the winner, MARCHING MAC (IRE), was found to have used his whip twice above the permitted level of six approaching the final furlong, and with his arm above shoulder height and in the incorrect place on the run to the line. He will be suspended for 15 days as follows: 07, 16 November, and 06, 12, 13 December and a further 10 days to be notified.
