Whip Review Committee Decisions 19 July 2024

On Friday 19 July 2024 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards and their own independent review of races for races run from 11 July – 17 July 2024, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Doncaster 11 July 2024

Race 2 – The Go Racing In Yorkshire Amateur Jockeys' Handicap Stakes (Class 6) (Div II)

Mr Matt Brown, the rider of CAN CAN GIRL (IRE), placed second, was found to have used his whip three times above the permitted level of six from two and a half furlongs out. He will be suspended for 10 days as follows: Friday 2, Tuesday 6, Wednesday 7, Thursday 8, Friday 9, Tuesday 13, Monday 19, Friday 23, Monday 26, and Tuesday 27 August.

Ayr 15 July 2024

Race 2 – The Ayrshire Cancer Support Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Rhys Elliott, the rider of GOLDEN VALOUR, placed second, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Friday 2 to Monday 5 August inclusive.

Beverley 16 July 2024

Race 4 – The Malcolm Greenslade Doncaster LVA Stalwart Memorial Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Rhys Elliott, the rider of STALLONE (IRE), placed fourth, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Tuesday 6 to Saturday 9 August inclusive.

Kempton Park 16 July 2024

Race 7 – The Unibet More Boosts in More Races Handicap Stakes (Class 6)

Sean Dylan Bowen, the rider of DILLYDINGDILLYDONG, placed second, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from two and a half furlongs out. Allowing for the fact that Bowen has had over 100 rides in Great Britain since a previous whip breach, mitigation on penalty was applied. Therefore, he will be suspended for 3 days from Friday 2 to Sunday 4 August inclusive.

Bath 17 July 2024

Race 5 – The Dragonbet - Born From The Betting Ring Handicap Stakes (Class 6) (Bath Summer Stayers' Series Qualifier)

Kevin Stott, the rider of the MASTERDREAM (FR), placed second, was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from two furlongs out. Allowing for the fact that Stott has had over 100 rides in Great Britain since a previous whip breach, mitigation on penalty was applied. Therefore, he will be suspended for 3 days from Friday 2 to Sunday 4 August inclusive.
