Whip Review Committee Decisions 7 June 2024

On Friday 7 June 2024 the Whip Review Committee convened to consider potential breaches of Rule (F)45 following referrals from the racecourse Stewards and their own independent review of races for races run from 1 June – 5 June 2024, inclusive. A summary of their findings is outlined below.

Lingfield 1 June 2024

Race 2 - THE CHOICE TRAINING MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Nicola Currie, the rider of PURE OF HEART (IRE), placed second, was found to have used her whip once above the permitted level of six and without allowing he mount time to respond from turning into the home straight. She will be suspended for 8 days from Monday 24 June to Monday 01 July.

Brighton 3 June 2024

Race 1 – The Download The Raceday Ready App Apprentice Classified Stakes (Class 6)

Jack Doughty, the rider of the winner, KONDRATIEV WAVE (IRE), was found to have used his whip once above the permitted level of six from two furlongs out. He will be suspended for 4 days from Sunday 23 to Wednesday 26 June inclusive.

Southwell 4 June 2024

Race 3 – The Prestige Safety "Your Trusted Safety Partner" Handicap Steeple Chase (Class 4)

Paddy Hanlon, the rider of BROWN MONDAY (FR), unplaced, was found to have used his whip without giving his mount time to respond. He will be suspended for 4 days as follows: Friday 21, Sunday 23, Tuesday 25, and Wednesday 26 June.

Wolverhampton 4 June 2024

Race 6 – The Get The Inside Track With Raceday-Ready.Com Handicap Stakes (Class 6) (Div II)

The winner, GLOBAL EFFORT (IRE), ridden by Luke Morriss, was found to have minor weals postrace. Morris will be suspended for 4 days from Sunday 23 to Wednesday 26 June inclusive.

Nottingham 5 June 2024

Race 3 – The Dont Miss Fiver Friday Raceday 19th July Handicap Stakes (Class 4)

Connor Murtagh, the rider of ROCK OPERA, placed second, was found to have used his whip twice above the permitted level of six from approaching the final furlong. He will be suspended for 7 days from Friday 21 to Thursday 27 June inclusive.
