Race 1 - 2:30pm.

THE CHESHAM STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for REACH FOR THE MOON to wear a red hood to the start.

Frankie Dettori, the rider of REACH FOR THE MOON, placed second, was suspended for 2 days for using his whip above the permitted level from 2 furlongs out.

Race 2 - 3:05pm.

THE JERSEY STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 3)

Permission was given for MUTASAABEQ to wear a hood in the Parade Ring, and for RHYTHM MASTER (IRE), STORM DAMAGE, LIGHT REFRAIN, and VADREAM to all wear a red hood to the start.

An enquiry was held to consider interference inside the final furlong when the winner, CREATIVE FORCE (IRE), ridden by James Doyle, interfered with STORM DAMAGE, unplaced, ridden by Andrea Atzeni. Doyle was cautioned for careless riding for allowing his mount to drift left-handed without correction, causing STORM DAMAGE to be taken off its line momentarily.



Jamie Spencer, the rider of VADREAM, placed third, was suspended for 2 days for using his whip above the permitted level from 2 furlongs out.

Following the race, David Egan reported that LEGION OF HONOUR, unplaced, hung right-handed under pressure, and William Buick reported that NAVAL CROWN, placed second, hung left-handed. Jim Crowley reported that MUTASAABEQ, unplaced, stopped quickly; the Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the colt failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 3 - 3:40pm.

THE HARDWICKE STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 2)

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that DEJA (FR), unplaced, had lost its left-fore shoe, and that ALBAFLORA, placed fifth, had spread its right-fore plate.

Race 4 - 4:20pm.

THE DIAMOND JUBILEE STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 1) (British Champions Series)

Permission was given for FINAL SONG (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

On the run to the line the winner, DREAM OF DREAMS (IRE), hung left-handed despite the rider's best efforts, causing GLEN SHIEL, placed second, to be carried off its intended line. It was found that no riding offence was involved and, taking into consideration the close proximity to the finish line as well as the fact that DREAM OF DREAMS (IRE) was ½ a length up on GLEN SHIEL at the time, it was found that it had not improved the placing of the winner.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that NAMOS (GER), unplaced, had lost its left-hind shoe. Frankie Dettori reported that FINAL SONG (IRE), unplaced, stopped quickly; the Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the filly failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 5 - 5:00pm.

THE WOKINGHAM STAKES (CLASS 2) (HERITAGE HANDICAP)

Permission was given for SNAZZY JAZZY (IRE) to go early to post and be mounted in the chute; the colt wore earplugs which were removed at the start.

Following the race, Ryan Moore reported that KING'S LYNN, placed third, was denied a clear run. The representative of Michael Dods reported that, despite having raced well on similar ground previously, PENDLETON, unplaced, was unsuited by the Soft, Heavy in places ground on this occasion; the gelding was routine tested. The Veterinary Officer reported that ABOVE (FR), unplaced, had lost both front shoes.

Race 6 - 5:35pm.

THE GOLDEN GATES STAKES (CLASS 2 HANDICAP)

Approaching the final half furlong the winner, FOXES TALES (IRE), ducked violently left-handed away from the whip, but did not inconvenience any other runners.

The performance of FANTASTIC FOX, which finished twelfth, beaten by 17¼ lengths, was considered. It was noted that the representative of Roger Varian reported that the colt ran too free.

Race 7 - 6:10pm.

THE QUEEN ALEXANDRA STAKES (CLASS 2 CONDITIONS RACE)

Following the race, Frankie Dettori reported that FALCON EIGHT, which started favourite and finished ninth, beaten by 24¾ lengths, was never travelling and hung right-handed throughout. D. K. Weld further added that the gelding had been unsuited by the Soft, Heavy in places going which, in his opinion, was tacky after a drying day. FALCON EIGHT was routine tested.
