**Race 1 - 1:55pm.**
**THE BETFAIR BEST ODDS ON ITV RACES FESTIVAL STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)**

Permission was given for EXTRA ELUSIVE and GLENDEVON (USA) to go early to post.

**Race 2 - 2:30pm.****THE BETFAIR EACH WAY EDGE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)**

Approximately 3 furlongs out, SPORTING CHANCE, unplaced, shifted right carrying CHYNNA, unplaced, onto PRINCE OF ROME (IRE), unplaced, which in turn shifted right causing the quarters of FANAAR (IRE), placed fourth, to be turned and then shift left, back onto PRINCE OF ROME (IRE), resulting in David Egan, the rider of PRINCE OF ROME (IRE), taking a check, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approaching the final furlong, INDIAN VICEROY, unplaced, ducked quickly right causing Joe Fanning, the rider of CHAPELLI, unplaced, to take a precautionary check, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

**Race 3 - 3:10pm.****THE READ RYAN MOORE EXCLUSIVELY AT BETTING.BETFAIR EBF MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 4) (PLUS 10 RACE)**

**Race 4 - 3:40pm.****THE BET YOUR WAY ON THE BETFAIR EXCHANGE TAPSTER STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)**

MIRACLE DANCER wore ear plugs which were removed at the start.

BARSANTI (IRE), drawn 5, anticipated the start and accelerated the gate at the same moment as the race had been started thereby enabling the gelding to break quickly. Being satisfied that it was not caused through a faulty action of the starting stalls, no further action was taken.

**Race 5 - 4:20pm.****THE BET IN PLAY ON THE BETFAIR EXCHANGE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)**

Permission was given for PLATITUDE to wear a hood in the Parade Ring.

**Race 6 - 4:55pm.****THE BETFAIR 3/1 FREE BET OFFER VETERANS' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)**

Following the False Start, all horses were checked by the Veterinary Surgeon at the start and were deemed fit to race.

An enquiry was held into the false start in this race. The Clerk of the Course, the Starters, a Steward (who had spoken with all of the riders unable to attend the enquiry due to onward engagements), Charlie Wallis and David Egan, the trainer and rider of ZAC BROWN (IRE), and the Advanced Flag Operator were interviewed. The Starter reported that ZAC BROWN (IRE) had broken out of the stalls prior to him pushing

the button to start the race and therefore immediately called a False Start. All riders correctly pulled up and returned to the start, as required by the recall procedures. ZAC BROWN (IRE) was withdrawn by the Starter for breaking out of the stalls. All remaining horses were checked by the Veterinary Surgeon at the start and deemed fit to race. The Stewards were satisfied that the recall procedures were carried out correctly and took no further action.

The Starter reported that ZAC BROWN (IRE) broke out of the stalls and was withdrawn. Charlie Wallis was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approaching 4 furlongs out when ENGLISHMAN, placed fifth, ridden by Pat Cosgrave interfered with SHAMSHON (IRE), placed third, ridden by Oisín Murphy. Cosgrave was cautioned for careless riding as he maneuvered left when insufficiently clear causing Murphy to take a slight check.

Following the race, P. J. McDonald reported that BOY IN THE BAR, placed second, was persistently denied a clear run in the final 2 furlongs. The Veterinary Officer reported that SHAMSHON (IRE), placed third, ENGLISHMAN, placed fifth and UPAVON, placed sixth, had post-race ataxia and that the winner, PADDY POWER (IRE), had bled from the nose.

**Race 7 - 5:30pm.**

**THE BETFAIR CASH OUT EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4)**

The Starter reported that PARISH POET (IRE) was reluctant to enter stalls. Paul Cole was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.
